I am pleased to inform you about the 3 projects that have been completed so far by us during the period from mid May to 28th June 2021.

PROJECT 1

Provision of essential items to the COVID Intermediate Hospital, Seeduwa as requested by the SevaVanitha Unit of the Sri Lanka Army.

This included the following items: 100Nos. phoenix plastic chairs, 500Nos. bath towels, 01 No. 12 Kg fully automated LG washing machine, 15Nos. jumbo garbage bins, 500 packs sanitary towels.

Total cost of all items Rs.552,740.00

Total collection Rs.554,322.58

This project was entirely funded by the “Friends in Dhamma” of Ontario, Canada, headed by Mr. Mahinda Gunasekera. We facilitated this donation at his request.

PROJECT 2-A

Provision of 150 pulse oximeters to the Ministry of Health

Cost of 150Nos. pulse oximeters Rs.750,000.00

PROJECT 2-B

Provision of dry food item bags to 350 families in Bogaswewa

Cost of 350 food bags Rs.357,000.00

Total cost (A + B) Rs.1,107,000.00

This project was mainly funded by “Friends in Dhamma” from Perth, Australia headed by Mr. Ananda Thilakasiri (Rs.837,000.00). The other overseas philanthropists donated Rs.190,382.00. The contribution of membership of Success Colombo for this project was Rs.79,000.00

Establishment of the high flow oxygen system at Kalawana Hospital, Sabaragamuwa District.

Cost of the entire project Rs.2,084,691.72

Total collection for the project Rs.2,112,540.00

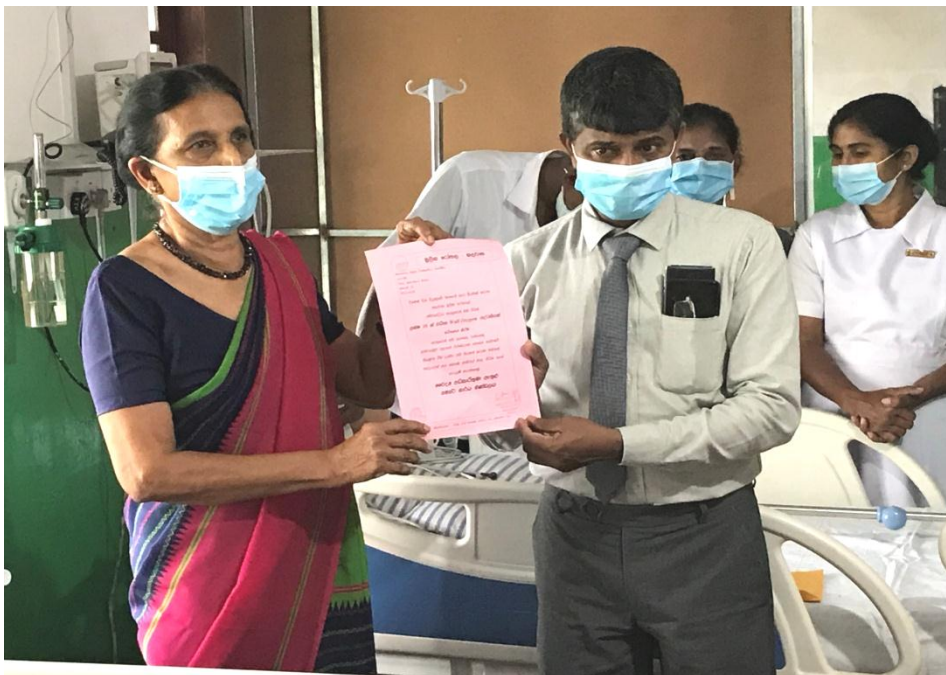
